During the spring of 2021, Boden and Luleå municipality carried out an inventory of uninhabited properties in the Råne and Vitå river valleys via the cross-municipal project Grow together. According to our information, you owned a house where no one was registered. Do you have your own plans for the house or would you consider selling/renting it out? In such cases, you would contribute to more people being able to move in or stay in their home area. Which in turn leads to more children going to preschool and school, services such as gas station and store can remain and new businesses can start up in the areas. We are aware that there can be several reasons why a property is considered unoccupied, perhaps it is a holiday home where you spend a lot of time or there is something that hinders the process such as coownership, emotional ties or that it simply feels too complicated.
